#### EOI FOR CONSTRUCTION APPLICATION

The Association of Non-Governmental Organizations in the Gambia (TANGO), as part of The **Gender Promotion Initiative (GPI 2.0)** Project, is currently working on strengthening it's coordination role and reposition the organisation strategically in fulfilment of its core goals and objectives.

**The GPI 2.0** Project is capacity building and institutional strengthening Project to support the Civil Society in the Gambia. The institutional capacity of civil society organisations to promote gender equality and women's empowerment, especially in rural areas, and augment solidarity among civil society organisations. Through this project, the capacity of civil society organizations (CSOs) in The Gambia will be strengthened, especially the women-led and women-focused organisations. This is in collaboration with the government through the active involvement of the Ministry of Gender, Children and Social Welfare, for effective coordination, and mainstreaming initiatives to promote gender equality and women's empowerment in the implementation of the initiatives.

In the recently conducted assessment among the CSOs across the three regions revealed low capacity in institutional development and many of them lack operational base. One of the recommendations from the assessment is to have a rallying point for the CSOs in each of these regions, which in turn will aid the coordination activities of TANGO. Therefore, with the support of other umbrella organisations, TANGO is sending out this bid for the construction of CSO Houses in Basse (URR), Soma (LRR) and Brikama (WCR).
